in the EU countries“**

The Project “**Improvement of students’ practical skills on car repair in the EU countries**“ is prepared by Ukmerge school of technologies and business and is intended for improving of practical professional skills of car repair students in order to reach better opportunities and more successful integration into the labour market.

The participants of project: The participants of the project are 35 undergraduate students of car repair speciality : 6 students from Ukmerge school of technology and business, 6 students from Kaunas mechanical school , 6 students from Panevezys Vocational Training Centre, 6 students from Utena regional vocational training centre and 5 students from Kelme vocational training centre. The project is relevant to all students participating in it, because the question of successful integration into the labour market is very important for all of them.

Project objectives: The overall objective of the project is - to develop practical, professional skills in the context of pan-European car repair and maintenance in order to reach better opportunities and more successful professional integration into the labour market. The main goal will be pursued through the following tasks:

1. To improve already existing car repair and maintenance, practical, professional skills and acquire new ones, using the modern techniques and equipment of car repair and maintenance;
2. To develop teamwork skills, communication skills, sense of responsibility, self-reliance;
3. To improve the practical skills of foreign language in general and professional area;
4. To develop adaptation skills in a new culture environment and to gain experience in international mobility.

Project location: Germany, Austria and Latvia. The countries are chosen because of their well-developed automotive industry. The internship in these countries modern car repair and maintenance companies and vocational training centres will allow to implement all the project’s objectives.
